



## Sunrise Scholarship

The Sunrise Scholarship, for early career teachers, is made possible by a generous gift to OCTM by Trudy Mitchell, longtime OCTM member and math educator. The scholarship is in honor of Trudy’s father. The title of the scholarship, Sunrise, has a two-fold meaning. First, the “sunrise” years of teaching are the early years in a teacher’s career and, second, Sunrise, Wyoming, was a small mining community where Trudy’s father was the superintendent of the mine.

The Sunrise Scholarship will be used to provide support for early career teachers to attend two consecutive Northwest Math Conferences when they are held in Oregon. In return, recipients agree to volunteer to help out in some way, however small or large, at the second of these two conferences.

**Qualifications and requirements:**

- Applicants should be early career teachers who have not completed five years of full-time teaching in an Oregon classroom.
- Recipients agree to attend two consecutive Oregon-based Northwest Math Conferences with support from the Sunrise Scholarship.
- Recipients agree to volunteer to help out in some way, however small or large, at the second of these two conferences.
- The scholarship will be distributed in two payments:
  - ✓ The first payment will be for \$300 to support the recipients to attend their first Oregon –based NW Math Conference.
  - ✓ The second payment will be \$200 to support teachers to attend their second Oregon-based NW Math Conference, but will be given IF, and only if, the teacher volunteers to help at this second conference.
- Applicants must be an OCTM member and must maintain that OCTM membership for the three years between the two conferences.
